

Y6 World War II

Science

This half term we will be learning about animals including humans.

During this topic we study the circulatory system, the digestive system, and the impact of diet, exercise drugs and lifestyle on their bodies function.

PE

This term we are developing the skills of tag rugby and hockey.

ENGLISH

This term our English lessons will be based on *Carrie's War* written by Nina Bawden.

The author the Year 6 children will be studying will be David Almond.

We are beginning our term by writing a diary entry based on a day during Lockdown.

As always we are encouraging reading at home with rewards of House Points.

We will continue to use the Oxford Owl spelling programme daily to ensure all children make good progress in this area.

Maths

As always, there's continuing work on **addition**, **subtraction**, **multiplication** and **division**. We will also be working on problem solving and reasoning.

Times Table knowledge is critical for good progress to be made. Practise in this area at home will be of great benefit to your child.

BMV/ RSE

This term we will be focusing on the core themes of British Values. These are: democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith. These link nicely to our WWII topic.

We will also be studying family as part of our newly statutory RSE curriculum.
